1. Board of Directors election

2. Trail Bridge Repair


The bridge along the trail just west of Encino Drive was temporarily closed due to safety concerns. A temporary repair has been made, and a permanent repair is expected to be completed in December.

3. Pool Update

A. The engineering design for the pool expansion is under way (plan below). The engineering plans will be bid for construction in early December with construction to follow as soon as permitting allows.

B. The Board is reviewing a bid for a new virtual video surveillance system for the pool which will replace the attendant pool monitor (at a significant cost savings). This system will allow 24/7 virtual monitoring of the pool, playground, and construction of the pool expansion project. It also provides offsite storage of the video in the event video is needed for police reporting purposes.

4. Other Updates

A. Ramps are being added at the east terminus of Blueberry Hill Drive and at the end of the Encino Drive Cul-de-Sac to allow direct access to the trail so residents do not have to cut through yards and driveways to access the trail. The ramp installations should be complete in the next couple of weeks. A third ramp will be added at the south end of Frisco Hills Drive in conjunction with a roadway project the Frisco West Water District will be completing in 2021.

B. A sharing library is being added near the amenity center very soon.
